Having successfully completed their first year of middle school, 7th graders arrive to The Social Class with a little bit of swagger! What a perfect time to direct this newfound confidence towards peer leadership. Whether it is leading by appropriately navigating social media or having the confidence to be an “includer”, 7th grade at The Social Class is a year of reinforcing and building upon the skills acquired in our 6th curriculum. The 7th grade curriculum will focus on: Cell phone and social media essentials, making introductions, conversation skills, family manners, common courtesies, RSVP’s and writing thank you notes. Attendance in the 6th grade is not required for your child to join us in 7th grade!

Attire: Girls: Dress or blouse and skirt, comfortable and easy to dance in dress shoes

Boys: Pants, long sleeve button down shirt (tucked in with a belt), dress shoes; the final dance will require a sport coat and tie

Drop-off/Pick-up:

The MCC has requested that TSC participants NOT use the valet drop off circle. For drop-off and pick up, please park your car in a space and feel free to walk your child to the door if you would like. I will have one of my assistants there to show there where to go once inside. **The MCC has also requested that parents refrain from coming inside the club for drop off, pick up or pictures.** We will wrap up our evening at 7:30pm and the children will be dismissed to head outside to meet you for pick up.

Refund Policy: IMPORTANT

If I am forced to cancel any classes for any reason (Covid-19, inclement weather, illness, etc.), I will do my very best to offer a make-up date. If I am unable to host a make-up class, I will gladly reimburse you

\$50 for each class that is cancelled. For reference, in my 10 years of hosting TSC, I have only had to cancel 1 class ever, and this was due to the Spring 2020 Covid-19 outbreak. Please note that I do not offer make-up classes for students that have to miss class due to a conflict. I do, however, review the teaching content and dancing instructions from the previous class at the beginning of each subsequent class. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call, or email me.

If after registration, circumstances arise and your child will not be able to participate, The Social Class refund policy is as follows:

- If you withdraw before classes begin and a replacement can be found, you will receive a full refund, less a \$50 administration fee.**
- If you withdraw before classes begin and a replacement cannot be found, you will be reimbursed half of your money.**
- If you withdraw once classes have begun, you will not receive a refund.**

Food Allergies: If pertinent, please make sure and list any food allergies and sensitivities when completing the registration form.

Please Note: The Social Class is unable to make exceptions for children to register for a class that is different than the grade they are in. Additionally, we are only equipped to serve students who are socially mature, able to sit quietly and listen and are capable of interacting in an age-appropriate manner with students their own age.
