6th Grade Class: LEAP!

I absolutely love working with 6th graders! Sweet and eager to please, they soak up every ounce of what we offer at The Social Class! Embarking on the middle school years, they find themselves being stretched beyond their comfort zone and leaping into many new things! This class focuses on laying a solid foundation for manners, confidence and many important life skills. Lessons include: First impressions, a proper handshake, the importance of eye contact, conversation skills, being a gentleman and table manners. Students will also learn 5 popular line dances. The 6th grade class will meet four times throughout March and April of 2022. The final class will be a 5-course dinner, where all of their new skills will be on display! This class will be capped at 100 students (50 boys and 50 girls).

Cost: \$250

Dates: Dates for Spring 2022 are: Friday, March 18th; Thursday, March 31st; Friday, April 22nd; Thursday, April 28th

Time: The 6th grade class will meet from 6:00pm-7:30pm at the Marietta Country Club.

Attire: Girls: Dress or blouse and skirt, comfortable and easy to dance in dress shoes

Boys: Pants, long sleeve button down shirt (tucked in with a belt), dress shoes

Drop-off/Pick-up: Please drop your child off at the front door of the MCC and I will have one of my assistants there to show them where to go. We will wrap up our evening at 7:30pm and the children will be dismissed to head outside to meet you for pick up.

Covid-19: The Social Class will abide by the mandates issued by our local and state government. Masks may be worn, but will not be required at TSC, unless mandated by the local or state government. TSC understands that everyone has a different level of comfort during these times. If you feel uncomfortable with these guidelines, it might be best to wait and register for The Social Class once Covid-19 subsides.

Refund Policy: IMPORTANT

If I am forced to cancel any classes for any reason (Covid-19, inclement weather, illness, etc.), I will do my very best to offer a make-up date. If I am unable to host a make-up class, I will gladly reimburse you \$50 for each class that is cancelled. For reference, in my 10 years of hosting TSC, I have only had to cancel 1 class ever, and this was due to the Spring 2020 Covid-19 outbreak. Please note that I do not offer make-up classes for students that have to miss class due to a conflict. I do, however, review the teaching content and dancing instructions from the previous class at the beginning of each subsequent class. If you have any questions, please do not hesitate to call, or email me.

If circumstances arise and due to a conflict your child will not be able to participate, The Social Class refund policy is as follows:

- If you withdraw before classes begin and a replacement can be found, you will receive a full refund, less a \$50 administration fee.
- If you withdraw before classes begin and a replacement cannot be found, you will be reimbursed half of your money.
- If you withdraw once classes have begun, you will not receive a refund.

Food Allergies: If pertinent, please make sure and list any food allergies and sensitivities when completing the registration form.

Please Note: The Social Class is unable to make exceptions for children to register for a class that is different than the grade they are in. Additionally, we are only equipped to serve students who are socially mature, able to sit quietly and listen and are capable of interacting in an age-appropriate manner with students their own age.
